

What can you do at home?

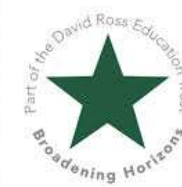
- ✓ The expectation is that children read daily. They should read to an adult as often as possible and adults must record each reading session in the home/school record.

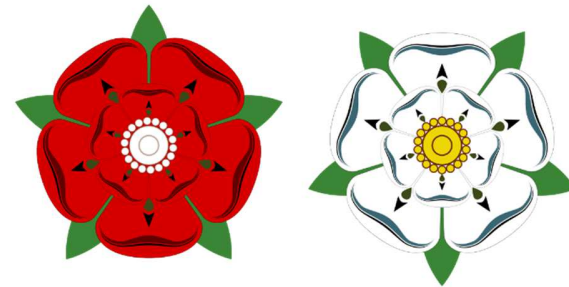

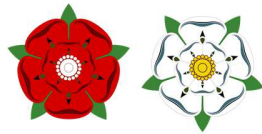
